## Descriptor(s):

**UETTDRRF03:** This Competency Standard Unit covers the performance of rescue procedures from an Elevating Work Platform (EWP) in the work place. It specifies the mandatory requirements of rescue from a raised EWP by a work party member on the ground and how they apply in the context of transmission, distribution or rail work functions. It encompasses responsibilities for, health, safety and risk management processes at all operative levels and adherence to safety practices as part of the normal way of doing work.

**UETTDRRF08:** This Competency Standard Unit covers the performance of Elevating Work Platform (EWP) controlled descent escape procedures in the work place. It specifies the mandatory requirements for self rescue from a raised EWP and how they apply in the context of transmission, distribution or rail work functions. It encompasses responsibilities for, health, safety and risk management processes at all operative levels and adherence to safety practices as part of the normal way of doing work.

**Unit Entry Requirements:** The prerequisite to UETTDRRF03 EWP Rescue is: HLTAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation. Whilst not specified within the units:

- Learners will need to be suitably trained and authorised to operate in this environment, in line with regulatory and/or network rules.
- To operate an EWP learners will require a “High Risk License”. This training may be completed without this license (under supervision) however the license would be required prior to operating an EWP.

**Duration:** Initial – 6 hours, Refresher – 3 hours

**Location:** ESITC or workplace nominated facility

**Mode of delivery:** Face to face
