**Unit Name:** Apply access procedures to work on or near electrical network infrastructure

**Status:** Current

**Descriptor:**

This Competency Standard Unit covers the performance of the procedures to gain access for work on or near electrical network infrastructure in the context of transmission, distribution or rail work functions. It encompasses responsibilities for, safety and risk management processes at all operative levels and adherence to safety practices as part of the normal way of doing work.

**Unit Entry Requirements:** There are no training package requirements for this course, however learners will need to be suitably trained and authorised to operate in this environment, in line with regulatory and network rules. Suitable training could be:

- UETTDRRF01 Apply ESI safety rules, codes of practice and procedures for work on or near electrical apparatus, or
- UETTDREL14 Work safely near live electrical apparatus as a non electrical worker

Experience operating as an “instructed person” would be advantageous.

**Duration:** Initial – 4.5 hours, Refresher – 2 hours

**Location:** ESITC or workplace nominated facility

**Requirements:**

- Basic literacy, numeracy and writing skills are required
